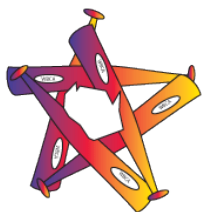
- If you are a pitcher, please refrain from pitching for **two days prior** to the start of the Classic.

THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT: We need you to collect a **MINIMUM** of \$225 in sponsorships. In the past, players have found this to be fairly easy. The highest amount ever collected has been \$1210. If you raise \$700 or more, the WBCA will present you with a \$100 scholarship or gift. Also, we will present an additional \$200 to the player that gathers the highest total. It costs \$21,000 for the WBCA to sponsor this event. Every player is **required** to collect the minimum. Your picture, statistics, and sponsorships will appear in the Classic Program, *if they arrive on time!* The money can be sent to Joe Waite by June 19th, but the ad page must be mailed to *Joe Waite in Cumberland* no later than **Friday, JUNE 5th..
